City Farm Boy is a small urban farming adventure in the heart of Vancouver, BC. City Farm Boy has been in business since 2006, building quality raised garden beds and growing food for the local farmers markets and wholesalers. We're unique in that our produce is grown on a collection of front and back-yard plots owned by Vancouver resident neighbours.

What this means is that City Farm Boy harvests travel only a short distance from our ground to your table. We can provide you with fresh, healthy vegetables from our bountiful gardens adorning our neighbourhoods. We offer the community fresh, new vibrant connections with food, farmers, land and each other.

City Farm Boy provides a much needed alternative to our increasingly ineffective and wasteful ways of producing and distributing food. Your support by membership and volunteering in this sustainability movement will be a voice for overall community health.

About the Urban Farmer



I was raised on a farm in Southern Saskatchewan, and fell in love with growing food at a young age. I got my BS in Agriculture, majoring in Horticulture, in 1989. I have been practicing as a Professional Agrologist since 1990 in a wide range of horticultural and agricultural businesses.

What is Community Supported Agriculture?

Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) is a locally charged commitment to bring the producers and consumers of food together to share the risks and rewards of growing food.

The Nitty-Gritty

Members buy a share at the beginning of the season. This money is used by the farmer to purchase seed and grow a crop of vegetables. In return, each member receives :

18 Veggies Bins thru the Growing Season

Pickup Begins - June 9th and continues thru to October 20th, weather dependant. Pickup is every week*, Thursday after 5 PM. If you cannot make it for pickup we will bin your veggies and you can pickup anytime.

Each member is responsible for bringing their own bag, sack, box, etc. The veggies are freshly harvested and can be wet, the carrots may still have some soil on them, the lettuce may still house a healthy slug.

Fresh harvest shares: Buying a share entitles members to a share of the seasonally harvested vegetables (and occasional fruit or flowers). Quantity and content will vary with the season, but will on average contain 8 to 10+ bundles, bunches, bags of veggies.

Financial sustainability: Payment is due in the spring. In doing so, the customer places their confidence in the farmer and agrees to share in the risks and variability of harvest.

Community satisfaction: In a well-functioning CSA, with Mother Nature's cooperation, shareholders can expect to receive more than their money's worth of healthy and fresh vegetables throughout the growing season.

Urban farming is taking root in Vancouver. We grow the food in collaboration with garden owners throughout our city and offer the harvest to neighborhood shareholders. Can you think of a better model for local food production and community building?
